15-minute appointments are made for initial and booster vaccinations. This allows for a complete health examination, questions about any concerns you have with your pet, discussion on preventive health (worms, fleas, diet, dental health and general husbandry), behaviour, care for the older pet etc.

Our Nurses also run FREE Clubs for Puppies, Kittens and Rabbits which cover everything important to maintain tip-top health.

Neutering Prices include pre-anaesthetic examinations, General Anaesthesia (with oxygen |Sevoflurane maintenance and GA monitoring by RCVS Registered Veterinary Nurses), preparation and theatre time, equipment and suture materials. Fees also include peri- and post-operative pain relief and one aftercare consultation. Any additional fees associated with aftercare will be chargeable.

There is a supplemental charge for obese or pregnant females and for retained testes in males.

Prescribing and Prescription Charges

The Veterinary Surgeon will produce a detailed written plan and estimate for all other Surgical, Hospitalisation or Investigative work and discuss this with you prior to embarking on any procedures.

Drugs and medications are dispensed and charged for as required. Injected or prescribed and dispensed drug prices include a 'Medication Decision/Prescribing Fee (MDF)' of £5.00 + VAT = £6.00. Alternatively, you may ask for a written prescription to obtain the same products at another pharmacy. (This may not be appropriate for inpatients or where urgent therapy is required). The cost of a written prescription is £27.50 and includes the MDF plus £21.50, for its preparation/printing etc.. The MDF is charged for the Vet's time and his or her pharmaceutical knowledge used to appraise each case, decide the appropriate drug and dosage regime and provide an appropriate treatment plan. It also covers the costs of disposables, wastage and managing a pharmacy at each site. The Prescription fee is charged each time a written prescription is given. The MDF is charged only when the Veterinary Surgeon is actively involved in preparing the prescription.

We do not charge an MDF fee on prescription/life stage diets, some preventive health products (dental hygiene products, non-POM-V medicines etc.), shampoos and certain other drugs.

Please ask for clarification on any of aspects of our pricing structure. You will be informed on request of the price of any medicine or procedure. Animals requiring repeat prescriptions are generally reassessed at 3 to 6month intervals depending on the nature of the condition. The standard charge for this is £42.00.
