Prescribing and Prescription Charges

The Veterinary Surgeon will produce a detailed written plan and estimate for all other Surgical, Hospitalisation or Investigative work and discuss this with you prior to embarking on any procedures.

*We charge for drugs and medications when they are prescribed, dispensed, or given by injection. All prescription-only medicines costs include a **Medication Decision/Prescribing Fee (MDF)** of **£5.50 + VAT (£6.60)**. This covers the vet's time, clinical judgement, and the costs of running our pharmacy.*

***You can choose to have a written prescription instead of buying the medication from us.** This allows you to get the same product from another pharmacy. (This may not be suitable for in-patients or when treatment is urgent.) **Written prescription cost:** £27.50 This includes the MDF plus £20.90 for preparing, printing, and issuing the prescription. The written prescription fee is charged each time a written prescription is issued, although one prescription charge can include several items and may allow repeats.*

*We do **not** charge an MDF on prescription diets, life-stage diets, some preventive health products (such as dental care items, flea and worming products, non-POM-V medicines), shampoos, and many other over-the-counter items.*

Please ask for clarification on any of aspects of our pricing structure. You will be informed on request of the price of any medicine or procedure. Animals requiring repeat prescriptions are generally reassessed at 3 to 6-month intervals depending on the nature of the condition. The standard charge for this is £46.50.

15-minute appointments are made for initial and booster vaccinations. This allows for a complete health examination, questions about any concerns you have with your pet, discussion on preventive health (worms, fleas, diet, dental health and general husbandry), behaviour, care for the older pet etc.

All Prices are inclusive of VAT

Neutering Prices include pre-anaesthetic examinations, general anaesthesia, preparation and theatre time, equipment and suture materials. Fees also include peri- and post-operative pain relief and one aftercare consultation. Any additional fees associated with aftercare will be chargeable.

Neutering - there will be a supplemental charge for obese or pregnant spays and for retained testes in males.

Dental prices include anaesthetic, pain management and other required medication. Price includes treatment for mild periodontal disease, descale and simple extractions. More complex dental work will be estimated on an individual basis.
